Note about the story

We'll Always Have Summer is the third and last of three famous books about Belly and her feelings for Conrad and his brother, Jeremiah. It follows *The Summer I Turned Pretty* (also available in Penguin Readers, level 3), which has become a television program, and *It's Not Summer Without You* (available in Penguin Readers, level 4). In *It's Not Summer Without You*, Conrad and Jeremiah's mother, Susannah Fisher, dies. At the end of the book, Belly and Jeremiah begin to **date***

In this story, although Belly is only 18, she decides to get married. Before their wedding, the couple getting married often have a party. For a man this is called a **bachelor party**, and for a woman this is a **wedding shower**.

At the wedding, there will often be **bridesmaids**, usually chosen by the woman, and a **best man**, chosen by the man.

“You look **hot**,” Jeremiah said when he came to meet me.

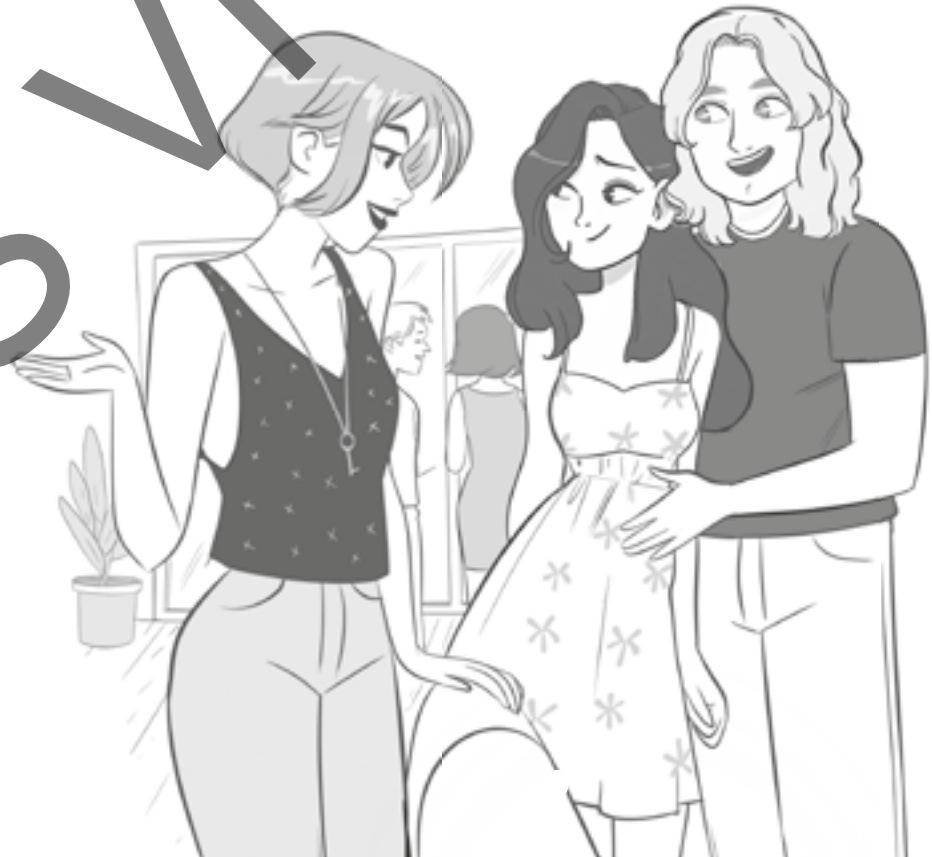
